ATTENTION PROPERTY OWNERS AND PLUMBING, HEATING AND ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS

It is unlawful for a property owner to pull a homeowner's plumbing, heating, or electrical permit and have licensed contractors do the work.

Licensed contractors *must* pull their own permits and call for inspections.

Please be advised that if the above statements are not adhered to, then tickets will be issued to the respective parties in violation.

> Work done prior to pulling a permit is subject to double fees.

Note: The license registration is good until your license expires.

WHEN PULLING A PERMIT BY MAIL PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING FOR *EACH APPLICATION*.

- 1. Include **building permit number** if there is one, address & job description/items.
- 2. Enclose a copy of contractor's license every time.
- 3. Enclose a copy of contractor's driver license every time.
- 4. Contractor must sign and date application; if an agent is pulling the permit on behalf of the licensed contractor a notarized letter on company letterhead giving permission to the agent must be submitted.
- 5. Always indicate the number of inspections you need.
- 6. Each application Must be filled out completely.

We need one copy with the above information for *each and every application* – filled out in full.

Plumbing, Heating and Electrical permit fees and applications are available on the web at <u>www.highlandtwp.net</u>; Building permit applications are also on the site.

If ALL of the above information is not included then the application will be returned unprocessed.
